
The Florida Department of Transportation invites you to attend a public hearing for the above referenced project. The proposed improvements involve US 301 (SR 200) from CR 227 to CR 233, a distance of 7.3 miles.

This public hearing is being held to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed improvements. The locally preferred alternative will provide a new four-lane, limited access roadway west of Starke. Overpasses will be constructed over CR 100A, the CSX railroad and CR 229. Grade separated interchanges will be constructed to provide access at SR 100 and SR 16.

As of December 20, 2012, draft project documents will be available for review at the Bradford County Library, 456 W. Pratt St., Starke, Florida 32091. Persons wishing to submit a written statement may do so at the hearing or mail them to the address provided no later than January 22, 2013.
